



IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL CENTREPORT LANDS BUSINESS OWNERS, TENANTS AND RESIDENTS

July 27, 2021

With the growth we are experiencing in the CentrePort area, the Rural Municipality of Rosser has received many questions and concerns regarding addressing and receipt of mail, especially to new businesses in the area. This includes Courier deliveries and the confusion of a Winnipeg postal code being utilized for mailing purposes within the Municipality of Rosser.

The Municipality has been working closely with Canada Post to create a new postal code for the Rosser area within the boundaries of the perimeter highway that contain CentrePort Lands. Note that this project will utilize community mailboxes currently in place plus the installation of new community mailboxes, in some locations.

While the project is in the early stages, please note that Canada Post will be sending out two letters, in the near future. The first letter will be sent 60 days in advance of the implementation to customers and will explain that changes to your mailing address is coming. The second letter will be sent 30 days prior to implementation and provide more specific information such as where to register and pick up keys for the community mailboxes. The municipality is also providing notice at this time to assist businesses in future planning, in relation to minimizing the ordering of printed matter that may contain your current mailing address, that will be subject to change.
